II. News from the Faculty

III. Funding!!!

 <u>Shane Perrine, PhD</u> received funding for his VA Merit grant, "Cannabinoids for posttraumatic stress disorder and alcohol use". Dr. Perrine as PI, along with Co-Investigator Dr. Alana Conti,



received this 4 year grant that will be conducted at the VAMC as well as WSU. Along with Co-Investigator, Dr. Alana Conti, Dr. Perrine's study aims to look at Cannabinoids as a potential treatment in comorbid/dual diagnosis of PTSD and Alcohol use. This study will be conducted over the next 4 years at both the VAMC and WSU and is a result of a large multi-disciplinary effort across the university.

- <u>Shane Perrine, PhD</u> received a NIDA supplement to his RO1 to have a student assistant join his lab for 8 weeks. Dr. Perrine brings on Eastern Michigan student Jamaine Atkins this summer.
- Drs.
